





- This congress (2018)

 - 367 oral presentations, 435 poster tours, 1819 scientific posters

















The full version of the 6 strategic goals for 2023

OML update





- The EULAR Outcomes Measure Library (OML) is an in-progress structured library, led by rheumatologists, constructed thanks to a Eular grant in 2012.
- It includes patient reported outcomes (PROs) and other indices frequently used in rheumatology to evaluate treatment response and to guide clinical decisions.
- It is freely available online since November 2013 (http://oml.eular.org/) and connected to the main EULAR website.



OML update







- Since 2017, the OML it is also available through the Eular App.
- The app includes also calculators of the most widely used indices.
- The Eular App can be downloaded at the Eular School of Rheumatology as part of the educational materials
