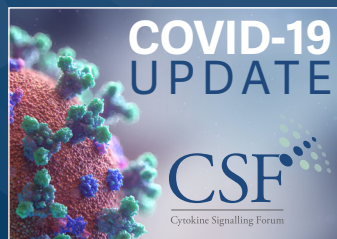


Cytokine Signalling Forum COVID-19 webinar
